

THE HOLDINGS OF THE EMIL BÜHRLE
COLLECTION: ILLUSTRATED LIST
OF ALL 633 PURCHASES

This list was compiled from the archive of the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection in Zurich and contains all 633 purchases of artworks (paintings, paper-based works, sculptures) made between 1936 and 1956 by Emil Bührle (1890–1956) for his private collection (as well as three works received as gifts in the 1920s). Wherever necessary and feasible, other archives and catalogues raisonnés have been consulted to fill gaps.

An unillustrated addendum contains a list of works by Swiss artists purchased for the premises of Werkzeugmaschinenfabrik Oerlikon Bührle & Co. and a list of the works acquired (through gallery owner Max Kaganovitch) as a result of the “Prix Bührle” held in Paris in 1952 and 1953. Unlike the list of 633 purchases, these two lists make no claim to provide a complete record.

This index includes neither the isolated specimens of classical art and applied art owned by Emil Bührle nor the approximately 110 works by Old Masters from Han Coray's collection that Bührle purchased for resale in 1940, all of which were divested by 1949 in collaboration with Lucerne's Galerie Fischer.

The index of Bührle's 633 purchases falls into two parts. The first lists the paintings, paper-based works and modern sculptures, while the second contains the (mostly) medieval sculptures. Each is ordered chronologically by date of purchase, although in a few cases (group purchases and payments by instalment) the chronology follows the date of invoice. Where purchase dates are identical, the alphabetical sequence is based on the artist's surname or (for medieval sculptures) the place of origin. Where works are by the same artist, the titles are in alphabetical order.

The locations of works were valid on the date when the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection was established in February 1960. For the thirty-seven works that left the collection in Bührle's own lifetime, the index gives the date of disposal and the name of the recipient. The same applies to the thirty-three works sold by the collector's heirs before the foundation was established.

Works permanently endowed to the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection by Bührle's heirs in 1960 show the inventory number allocated to them in the foundation's charter. Works donated to the foundation in 1960 to be held for sale are listed with their inventory number, the year of sale after 1960 and the purchaser. The same details are provided for works deaccessioned after 1960.

All the works belonging to the foundation in 2021 are illustrated in colour. Works allocated to the foundation for sale in 1960 and works deaccessioned by the foundation after 1960 are illustrated in black and white.

The location of works that remained in private ownership when the foundation was established in 1960 is given as "1960: PO". These are illustrated in black and white.

A small number of works could not be identified, and in these instances the illustration shows the document (usually an invoice) demonstrating that the work once formed part of the Emil Bührle Collection.

The Emil Bührle Collection is extremely grateful to the heirs and commercial successors of the art dealers from whom Emil Bührle bought works for providing essential information and for their trustful collaboration. Valuable input was also contributed by Laurie A. Stein, based in Chicago and Berlin, whose research for the Emil Bührle Collection helped to tap other archives for source material about purchases by Emil Bührle.

An unillustrated, less-detailed version of this list was first published in the exhibition catalogue *Chefs-d'œuvre de la collection Bührle: Manet, Cézanne, Monet, Van Gogh...*, edited by Lukas Gloor and Sylvie Wuhrmann, from the Fondation de l'Hermitage in Lausanne, 2017, and has since then been regularly updated and posted on the website of the Emil Bührle Collection (www.buehrle.ch). The website also provides detailed provenance reports backed by sources for all the works owned by the foundation.

Each entry in the list below contains the following details:

- purchase number: in running order except for items of looted art subject to restitution; in these cases, works that left the collection definitively upon restitution retain their place in the running order, whereas works repurchased from the rightful owner after restitution are renumbered to reflect the date of the second purchase;
- name (or alias) of the artist; or, for anonymous works and medieval sculptures, supposed region and period of origin;
- title, production year, technique, dimensions: titles for works by French artists are given in French, as listed in the catalogue raisonné where available; all other titles have been translated into English, as in the case of Mary Cassatt, where the catalogue raisonné has been followed; no production year is suggested for attributions, fakes or unidentified works or for works where the relevant literature does not provide a year of origin;
- abbreviated, numbered reference to the catalogue raisonné; these reference works have been arranged by artist at the end of the index (e.g. "D." for Bonnard = Jean Dauberville and Henry Dauberville, *Bonnard: Catalogue raisonné de l'œuvre peint*, 4 vols [Paris: Bernheim-Jeune, 1965–74]). If a work is not listed in the catalogue raisonné, the abbreviation is followed by - (e.g. "D.-"), and if the work cannot be identified in the catalogue raisonné, the abbreviation is followed by ? (e.g. "D.?");

- vendor as displayed in the alphabetical index of names at the end of the list;
- date of purchase: the date of the latest proof of purchase, i.e. (1) confirmation by vendor of receipt of payment, (2) confirmation of receipt of payment order issued by Emil Bührle to Industrie- und Handelsbank, Zurich, (3) payment order issued by Emil Bührle to Industrie- und Handelsbank, Zurich, (4) other form of payment by Emil Bührle (e.g. cheque), (5) date of purchase on the index card, (6) date of purchase in the accession register;
- purchase price: the price is indicated in the original currency wherever this is documented and has either been converted into Swiss francs at the historical rate drawn from a table published by the Swiss National Bank in the *Statistisches Monatsheft* of August 2015 (~ CHF) or else reflects the conversion rate shown in a historical document (= CHF); if a work formed part of an exchange, the final price is shown (= CHF) after deducting the amount credited for the work traded in; if several works were purchased at once, they are marked * and the total payment is given next to * at the end of the listed group;
- location in 1960 (= establishment date of the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection), broken down into the following categories:

Inv. ## = work held by the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection (Inv. S## = medieval sculpture held by the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection); HS. ## = item held for sale by the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection (HS. S## = medieval sculpture held for sale); ex-Inv. (ex-Inv. S##) = works deaccessioned from the Foundation's permanent holdings; the translations serve the purpose of making the various categories of inventory numbers understandable to the English-speaking reader; the inventory numbers listed in the German edition of this book are authoritative;

1960: PO = kept by the collector's heirs after division;

- in the event of an exchange, restitution, return to vendor or outright sale: recipient (art dealers are detailed at the end of the list);
- current location if now in an identified public collection.





The Emil Bührle Collection: Works by Swiss artists

There is no complete surviving index of the works by Swiss artists in the Emil Bührle Collection. The information provided here was primarily derived from two lists, the first of which was published in *Werkmitteilungen* 7, no. 2 (1947), the newsletter of Werkzeugmaschinenfabrik Oerlikon Bührle & Co. (WOB). That list gave no details about size or technique, and so works found only there are listed here without these data. The same applies to the second list preserved in the archives of the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection, a typed document compiled in January 1952 by Walter Drack, the collection secretary, which features all the works in the collection at that point, including those by Swiss artists. This is the only document to mention the Swiss works in connection with the Emil Bührle Collection. Bührle maintained a strict separation between the international section of his collection, kept in his private home or in the house next door on Zollikerstrasse, and the Swiss art, which never entered his home and was intended exclusively for the company premises. Another important source for the list below was the exhibition catalogue *Schweizer Maler aus der Sammlung Bührle*, published by the Foundation E.G. Bührle Collection (Zurich, 1990–91, cited below as "Cat. 90/#"). In rare cases, the foundation archive contains additional documents about Swiss works, but these do not always indicate dimensions or technique. Unless otherwise stated, all the works remained in private hands in 1960.

The Emil Bührle Collection: The "Prix Bührle" in 1952 and 1953

In 1952 and 1953 Emil Bührle sponsored a "Prix Bührle" in Paris, implemented on his behalf by the gallery owner Max Kaganovitch. Participation was by invitation only and the submissions were put before a jury composed of collectors, art critics and museum experts. Bührle did not take part in the work of the jury. The three prize-winners were rewarded by the purchase of their winning entries for 100,000, 50,000 and 25,000 French francs; Bührle also bought the other submissions for a set amount. All these works remained in private hands in 1960.
